

Annual Member Survey Results

Our Annual Member Survey was distributed in May 2024 to collect feedback and input from chapter members on programs, events, and services offered. In accordance with Chapter Bylaws, the survey remained open for a two-week period. There was a significant increase in participation from the prior year and an increase in satisfaction of programs, seminars, and social media from the prior year.



- Programs increased to 81.8%
- Seminars increased to 86.4%
