Speaker Bio: Jennifer Ratterman, CPA, CFE, CFF, joined the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Louisville Field Office in 2004 as a Financial Analyst and converted to Forensic Accountant in 2010. FoA Ratterman has over twenty years of experience investigating complex financial crimes, drug trafficking, and public corruption. She is currently assigned to the Homeland Security Task Force. Prior to joining the Bureau, she spent three years providing audit services at various public accounting firms and seven years as the accounting manager at a local printing company. She has a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting from Marquette University and holds Certified Public Accountant, Certified Fraud Examiner, and Certified in Financial Forensics certifications.

Internal Auditor Practitioner (IAP)

If you've passed Part 1 of the CIA® or ever held the full designation, you're eligible to lock in a credential that gives your hard work lifelong value: the Internal Audit Practitioner $^{\text{TM}}$ (IAP $^{\text{TM}}$).

- No exam. No coursework.
- Permanent* recognition of your experience.
- Show your advanced audit credibility.

Apply for your IAP before June 2026.

*IAP holders must earn 20 hours of CPE each year and complete the annual certification renewal process beginning in 2026.

Online Proctoring Ended May 28

The Professional Certifications Board (PCB) provided conditional approval for online proctored exams in 2021, as a precautionary solution during the COVID -19 global pandemic. That conditional approval expired as the 2019 CIA syllabus was retired.

To preserve the integrity of IIA certification programs, reduce misconduct cases, and enhance the testing experience for all candidates, the decision was been made to transition back to a **test center-only delivery mode**l. **Effective 28 May 2025,** online proctoring was discontinued permanently.

The examinations are now administered in multiple languages exclusively in Pearson VUE test centers around the world. For more information and a tutorial about the testing center visit the IIA site – Test Center Information.
